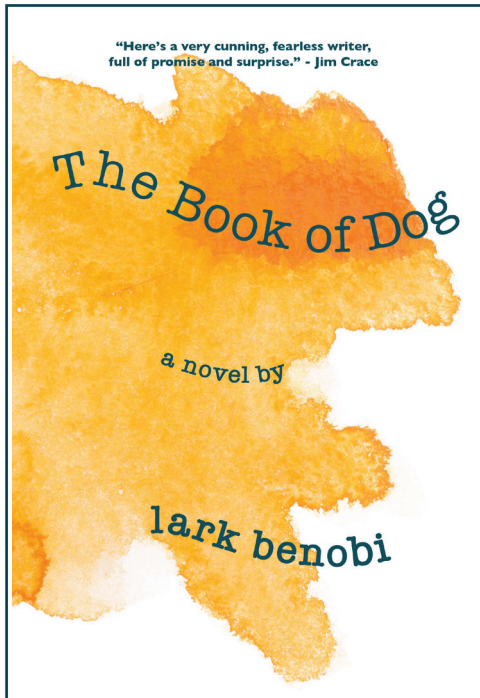


# The Book of Dog

14. What's the last book that made you laugh?
15. What's the last book that made you cry?
